




INTERVENTION 1 – PARKING PLACE TRANSFORMED TO PLAYGROUND

- The city which is planned in an integrated way, intended with the aim of activation public spaces, with a decentralization of activities and development of polycentricism and all that through the civil participation.
- The city that is compact, planned in accordance with demographic predictions, which recycles its spaces, encourages multi-functional and energy efficient construction connected with a quality infrastructure which, among other, allows sustainable mobility.
- The city that keeps its natural environment and natural resources encourages the symbiosis of urban and rural areas inside the preserved green zone.
- The city that is a leading healthy city with happy and long lived citizens with available: healthy adequate water for drink highly standardized organic food, good air quality and waste management system.
- The city in which long-life, free, critical, creative and holistic education is available for everybody, produces active citizens.
